

NOTICE OF 2017 TAX YEAR PROPOSED PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR

A tax rate of \$65500 per \$100 valuation has been proposed for adoption by the governing body of CITY OF BAY CITY This rate exceeds the lower of the effective or rollback tax rate,
and state law requires that two public hearings be held by the governing body before adopting the proposed tax rate.
The governing body of CITY OF BAY CITY proposes to use revenue attributable to the tax
rate increase for the purpose of MAINTAINING MINIMUM RESERVE LEVELS , HEALTH INSURANCE, & PUBLIC SAFETY
PROPOSED TAX RATE \$65500
The effective tax rate is the total tax rate needed to raise the same amount of property tax revenue for CITY OF BAY CITY from the same properties in both the 2016 tax year
and the 2017 tax year.
The rollback tax rate is the highest tax rate that CITY OF BAY CITY may adopt before voters are entitled to petition for an election to limit the rate that may be approved to the rollback rate.
YOUR TAXES OWED UNDER ANY OF THE ABOVE RATES CAN BE CALCULATED AS FOLLOWS: property tax amount = (rate) x (taxable_value of your property) / 100

This budget will raise more total property taxes than last year's budget by \$676,302 (14.60%), and of that amount \$75,486 is tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the roll this year.
